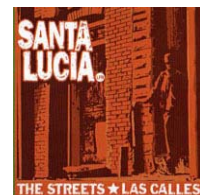

June 2nd, 2006 - Santa Lucia will be playing a free outdoor concert in Yaletown's David Lam Park on July 2nd as part of this year's TD Canada Trust Vancouver International Jazz Festival, one of the highlights summer festival season in Vancouver.
